

Subject: **HOMESTAY POLICY**

Covers: ALL ARRANGEMENTS FOR OBTAINING A HOMESTAY FAMILY

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to outline the requirements for obtaining a homestay family for a Collegiate student.

Background:

From time to time there is a need to provide a homestay for a student either in an emergency family situation or for a boarder who requires accommodation when the Boarding House is closed. Usually boarding arrangements are not made available during the mid-year break between Terms 2 and 3.

Policy:

Homestay families are sought from the wider Collegiate Community.

The procedure for meeting compliance requirements is as follows:

- The *Registration Form for Homestay Families must be completed.
- A home visit is made by a school representative to inspect the home and the facilities for the student.
- An interview is conducted with the prospective families by the school representative.
- A Working with Children (WWVP) card is obtained for all members of the family, over 16 years of age, who reside or frequently reside at the homestay premises.

Once this procedure is complete all documentation is provided to the Principal who then approves, makes a recommendation for modifications or refuses the homestay application.

The parents of the student are presented with the information about the recommended homestay family and if they are in agreement with the recommendation the necessary arrangements are made.

If the parents are not in agreement then another homestay family is sought. The School will endeavour to meet the expectations of the parents wherever possible.
